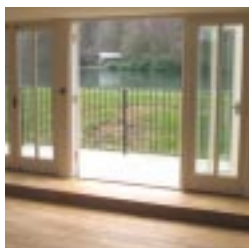

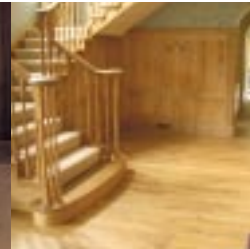

Hardwood Flooring

Hardwood flooring is both luxurious and practical. It brings warmth and beauty to your home and is also hardwearing and easy to clean. The floor is the foundation of your room design, and choosing the right species, colour, style and finish will ensure long-term satisfaction.



There are two main types of hardwood flooring:

Solid hardwood flooring - typically around 20mm thick, the boards are tongued & grooved all round and available in a wide variety of species and grades. Wood is a natural material and it absorbs and releases moisture from the surrounding environment, so there are some limitations on where solid hardwood flooring can be used.

Engineered flooring - typically comprising a 6mm thick layer of hardwood bonded to a 15mm tongued & grooved birch plywood substrate, engineered flooring offers greater stability than solid hardwood. Engineered wood floors can be glued down or floated. Originally developed for use with underfloor heating, the market is expanding rapidly due to its ease of fitting and the fact that it can be used for all applications. In addition, as the number of manufacturers has increased, so the cost has fallen.

Around 95% of hardwood flooring installed in the UK is oak, but this is changing as customers seek greater variety. Brill Sawmills can supply solid and engineered flooring in a broad range of temperate and tropical species.



Hardwood Doors

Today, doors are increasingly seen not just as 'hole fillers' but as items of furniture that add beauty, warmth and 'wow' factor to a home. The 'clunk' of a solid door closing means just one thing: quality.

For new-build, extensions, renovation and conversion projects we also supply standard and non-standard door linings.



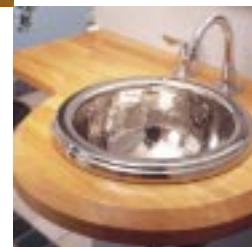
Kitchen Worktops

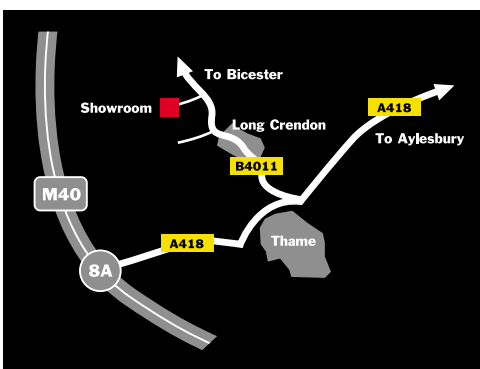
